All items with the school Kingfisher logo can be purchased via your Scopay account. We also keep stock of PE shorts and skorts. All other clothing can be purchased from any high street clothing shop.

<b>Book Bags</b> These can be purchased from the school office for children in Reception to end of Year 2. Children in Swift and Eagle Classes (Years 3-6) can use their own choice of bag.	<ul> <li>Swimming (Swift Class: Years 3 and 4 only)</li> <li>Costume (one-piece, no bikinis) and towel in appropriately sized bag.</li> <li>Swim shorts must fall above the knee; baggy swim shorts are not recommended for swimming lessons.</li> <li>Swimming hats must be worn by all children with hair which is long enough to cover their ears.</li> </ul>

\*Trainers are preferred for outdoor PE because, particularly as the children get older, they offer far more support to the ankle and stay on the children's feet!

Please note:

- Long hair must always be tied back for PE and Swimming.
- Earrings should not be worn on PE and swimming days. Staff cannot remove or tape earrings; children must be able to remove earrings themselves if necessary.
- Football boots and shin pads must be worn by all children who attend football club.

## Please ensure <u>all</u> clothing and kit bags are clearly named.
