At Great Sampford Primary School we strive to provide a safe, secure, pleasant environment, a happy and purposeful community where all children are respected and valued. Our aim is to meet the needs of the children in partnership with parents so they may be positive, articulate and responsible individuals prepared to play their part in society.

We encourage all members of the Great Sampford Community to respect one another, to know that every individual has an important part to play, to take responsibility and be responsible, to strive for excellence and try ones best for the school and for oneself.

To work towards achieving our aims, we have put together this Home- School agreement which we are going to use as the basis of our relationship with one another as a school community.

As a school we shall:

- Provide a safe, secure and stimulating learning environment.
- Care for pupils' safety and happiness and treat them with respect.
- Recognise the individuality of each child and develop them accordingly.
- Value the unique input that each child and family makes to the school.
- Encourage pupils to do their best in all aspects of school life.
- Provide parents and carers with regular information including newsletters and meetings to discuss progress.
- Provide a balanced, relevant curriculum that meets the needs of pupils.
- Offer targeted work and extra support for those children with specific educational needs and abilities.
- Offer opportunities for home learning (e.g. reading and homework).
- Have high expectations of parents and pupils, insisting that all discussions are respectful, not tolerating aggression or threatening behaviour from any quarter.
- Encourage children to take care of and take pride in both themselves and their surroundings.
- Offer opportunity, challenge and activities that encourage resilience.

Computing:

- Use a filtered Internet Service to prevent access to Internet sites with certain types of material.
- Wherever possible all Internet access during school hours will be supervised by a member of staff or other responsible adult.
- Identify which Internet sites have been visited and to monitor Internet access.
- Educate pupils as to how to keep safe online, including some of the issues they may encounter.
- Provide the children with a safe space to talk about inappropriate material found online.

- Make sure my child attends regularly and inform the school immediately of the reason for any absence.
- Support my child in their home learning (e.g. reading with them on a daily basis).
- Support my child's learning by working with outside agencies.
- Support the school's guidance and policy on behaviour.
- Set a good example to my own and other children when on school premises.
- Ensure that all forms and letters are read and returned promptly.
- Approach the teachers and other staff, parents and pupils in a respectful and non-threatening manner.
- Ensure that my correspondence with the school is courteous and purposeful reflecting a respectful manner at all times.
- Attend parent's consultations and discussions about my child's progress.
- Not fall behind with payments for services provided by the school.
- Co-operate with the school in drawing up re-payment plans if my family does experience financial difficulties.
- Provide my child with the Great Sampford school uniform, PE Kit and a book bag.
